

Data Privacy Statement

You have been chosen as an expert in one of the areas of mobility, traffic, settlement- or urban development, to participate in the AVENUE21 Delphi survey.

Your participation in this survey is voluntary and important. If you can not or do not want to participate, there won't be any negative consequences for you.

Avenue 21 is a research project at the future.lab, Technical University Vienna, and makes the following statement for the protection of your data:

All collected data is treated confidentially and will only be used for this survey and related research activity in the public interest. Your data will not be available to other authorities or private companies in personalized form. If you do not want to participate in the second round of the survey, all data that could identify you will be deleted after combining the questionnaires to a usable dataset. If you agree to participate in the second round, data that can identify you (name and e-mail address) will be separated from the rest of the data. Personalized data will only be used for the implementation of the second round and will be deleted after sending the second round. **Analysis will only be carried out with the anonymised data.**

According to the Austrian Datenschutzgesetz 2000 (data protection law of 2000) in the current version, with your explicit consent you allow us to use your (anonymised) data for the project AVENUE21 and connected research at participating departments at the TU Wien. Your Data will only be used for stated purposes and will not be passed on to other authorities or private companies. The legal basis for this is stated above.

According to §26 DSG2000 you have the right to information on your data and according to §27 DSG2000 you have the right to correction or deletion of incorrect or improperly used data, as long as your questionnaire has not been anonymised.
